We, the undersigned, Electors of President and Vice-President of the United States of America for the next ensuing regular term of the respective offices thereof, being Electors duly and legally appointed by and for the State of Virginia, as appears by the annexed list of Electors and the certificate of the Executive, made, certified and delivered to us by the direction of the Executive of the State, having met and convened in the City of Richmond, Virginia, and the seat of Government, at the Capitol, in pursuance of the Constitution and Laws of the United States, and also in pursuance of the Constitution and Laws of the State of Virginia, on the 18th day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-four.

DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that, being so assembled, we duly qualified and organized and that all the Electors duly and legally appointed by and for the State of Virginia appeared and answered to their names, and that thereupon, being duly in session at said Capitol on the 18th day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-four, we proceeded to vote by ballot, and balloted first for such President, and then for such Vice-President, by distinct ballots.

And we further certify that the following are two distinct lists, one of the votes for such President and the other of the votes for such Vice-President.

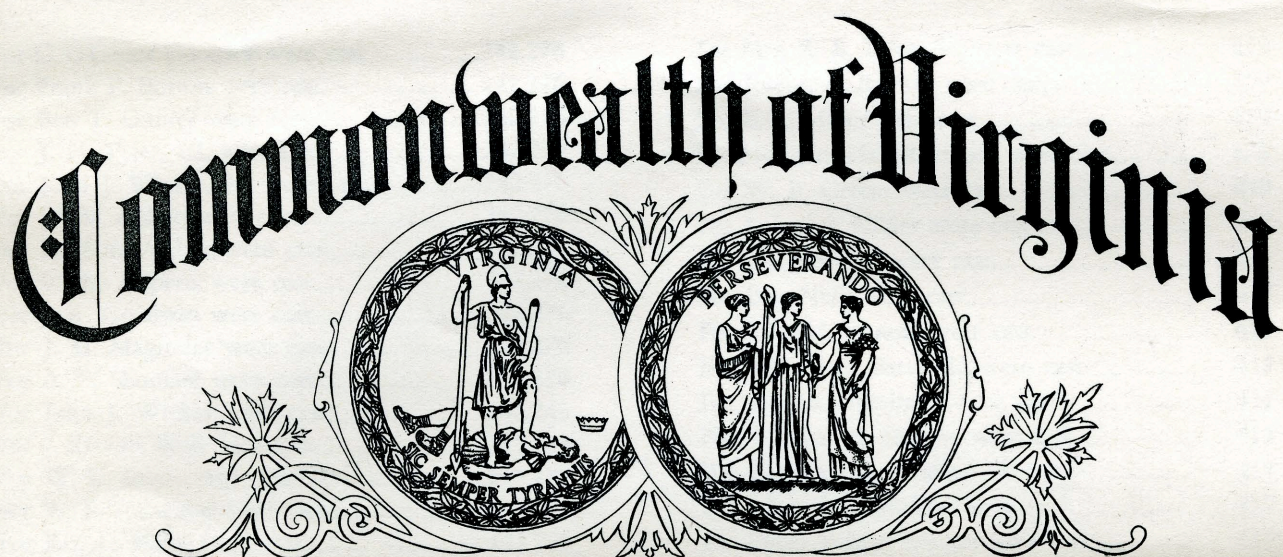
