Mor Orices John Deposes That about four Weeks ago he saw the Prisoner at mr. youngs Spring, he enlist to with Gabriel to fight the white people, and promised to meet in three weeks or there: abouts for that purpose - Gabriel observed We must slay them as We go, ho the prisoner said he would do so - he was to have the title and bommand of Captain -Propers Ben Deposes - That he went with Gabriel on friday night to Mr youngs, to see Ben Woolfolk whom they found in bed that he was waker up by Sawney and got up - Gabriel gave him money to buy liquor to treat with in Caroline whither he was shortly going to mouce hegroes in baroline to enlist, he expected that he had cix hundred already enlisted, he also told Gabril that he had then six Scythe Blaces in his room which were to be made into swoods, by Gabriel; and was about to bring themout which was prevented by its being inconvenient to Gabriel to carry them with him - That day fortnight Ben Woolfolk was to meet about minight at Propers Tween as he expected he could arive there by that time with his men from baroline - That Gabriel said they would slay the conter males from the bradle upwards, but the females of all ages were to be Spared - The presioner very readily agreed that this was the only way-bondemned and full confession made.
