would most respectfully represent, that they labour  
under great inconvenience from a want of back Streets  
in said Town, from stock of all kinds running at  
large in the streets, and Wood lying in and blocking  
up the streets, preventing the easy and comfortable  
passage of the citizens; as well as other inconveniences  
not necessary to be herein set forth, your petitioners would  
most respectfully ask for the passage of an act, incorpo-  
-rating the said Town of Newbern; empowering full corporate  
-powers to act concerning such matters as may be deem-  
-ed necessary for the wellbeing and advantage of the citi-  
-zens thereof; as well as such other regulations as will  
be necessary for the internal Police of the Town.  
Your petitioners do further ask, that a clause may be  
inserted in said act of incorporation, extending the limits  
of said Town, so as to embrace all lots and Houses within  
the distance of three furlongs from the Court House  
running East and West with the South Western Turnpike  
Road, and from said Turnpike Road, seventy five yards on  
each side running at right angle from said Road in a  
Northern and Southern direction, with a proviso that any  
privilege heretofore extended to the citizens of said Town  
shall not be compromised, your petitioners would deem  
the passage of any act of the General Assembly, emb-  
-rassing the objects above set forth as peculiarly advantage-  
-ous to them and as in duty bound they once ever  
pray.
