

Be it enacted by the General that the Auditor of Public
Accounts be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant
on the Treasury, [payable out of any money therein not other-
wise appropriated] in favor James W. Curwin, late
Sheriff of Pulaski County, or his legal representative for the
sum of two hundred and thirteen dollars and forty cents, that
being the amount of extra commission on the revenue ^{collected for}
the said County in the year 1856 of which he was deprived
by reason of his failure ^{promptly in the} to pay the ^{said} ~~amount~~ same.
