Whereas it appears by the Returns of the Commissioners appointed for the several Counties of this Commonwealth, the Cities of Richmond and Williamsburg, the Borough of Norfolk, and town of Petersburg, to superintend the election of Presidential Electors, that a majority of the votes polled at the said election were given in favor of the persons named below:
