They conceive a road from the upper end of Fredericksburg thro' the Islands now in the occupancy of Joseph Lawrence to the wharf leading from Harwoods to the Forge Mills on the north side of the Rappahannock in Stafford County would afford to them an easy & cheap access to Fredericksburg thereby giving them a choice of markets -
